Town Hall Accessibility Project Update

s of May 10, 55 people have completed the **Town Hall**Accessibility Project Survey. Of the surveys returned so far, however, there is no clear consensus on Wheelock residents' ideas and opinions, so completing your survey provides very important information for the project. By completing your survey, you help our consultant team and the committee volunteers develop the two designs they will present at a community meeting in early fall.

You can either fill out the survey you received in the mail or pick up one at Town Hall or the Wheelock Village Store. You can mail your completed survey to the address listed on the survey or drop it in one of the secure boxes at Town Hall or the store.

The Project So Far

he Town Hall Accessibility Proposal Project will be underway throughout the 2021 calendar year.

- The Project Committee (volunteers and consultants) meets on the second Monday of each month @ 6 p.m. (via Zoom).
- A consultant team has been hired to assist the Town to meet our obligation under the terms of the Department of Justice agreement.
- The consultant team's architect and landscape architect are reviewing prior plans and studies and will present recommendations for providing accessible, affordable, and attractive town government facilities.
- Information about the project is updated on the PlaceSense webpage on a regular basis. http://placesense.com/wheelock/
- The survey mentioned above follows up on last year's survey to Wheelock residents with more detailed questions.
- A community meeting in the early fall will provide a forum to present and discuss the first phase of work with Wheelock residents.
